Frederick is a repressed, introverted and unloved clerk at the local job centre but also a collector of butterflies and an eager amateur photographer. Winning the lottery he quits his job and buys a remote farmhouse. For a long time Frederick has been obsessed with Miranda, a beautiful privileged art student. But Frederick is not able to communicate with Miranda and decides to abduct her. Having imprisoned Miranda in his cellar he discovers the reality far from his fantasies.

CLOSE TO REALITY

"The Collector is a superb psychological drama, by turns sad, tense and horrific" tells Ian Burns, head of That Theatre Company. "And it is also very close to reality: The last few decades have seen numerous examples worldwide of horrifying stories about men who have imprisoned children and women for several years. Just think of Austrian Wolfgang Priklopil who kept Natasha Kampusch in his cellar for eight years. The Collector is a most qualified attempt to explain the inner life of such an abductor and his victim in a way that is not purely black and white."

The Collector will be performed **October 27. to November 27.** at [Krudttønden](#) (Serridslevsvej 2, just across Østerbro Svømmehal). Monday to Friday at 8 pm and Saturday at 5 pm. **Ian Burns** plays the part of Frederick and Danish actress **Maria Lohmann**, who has been based in UK since 2003, has her Danish debut as Miranda. **Claus Bue** directs the Collector.
